Webster Hills Preschool

For 61 years, Webster Hills Preschool has served as a ministry of Webster Hills UMC. What started as a morning out program for parents has turned into an education staple in Webster Groves. We currently serve 56 kids and 42 families. We have been able to give scholarships to families who wouldn't be able to afford tuition if it were not for the generosity of donors to the preschool.

Webster Hills Preschool is a school for play-based learning through a creative curriculum. That means we focus on the value of play to learn and grow academically, physically and socially-emotionally based on the interests of our teachers and students. We have been blessed with 13 amazing teachers with a combined years of experience of over 75 years teaching. The students have chapel once per month, where they learn about how God loves them and wants to be their friend forever. Preschool families over the past several years have started to worship with Webster Hills, become members and join the many family friendly events held each year.

Under the direction of Amy Musgraves and Kyle Kranes-Rutz, we have extended the hours for our 4/5-year-olds from a 9-12 option to 9-2 option. Additionally, We are hoping to get back to our average number of students at 70 (which was pre covid). Amy and Kyle have petitioned and been awarded an extension to our CUP (conditional Use Permit) to serve our community with the option of part time or full-time care Monday-Friday 8am-5pm.


Planned Giving



Frequently Asked Questions

Q: How much should I give?

A: At Webster Hills, we lift up the Old Testament model of giving 10 percent of your income. Some start with more or less and grow in their giving each year.

Q: How do I decide what to give?

A: We believe it's important to start by giving a set percentage on a regular basis. You may choose to give weekly, monthly or annually. Before giving: Ask God for direction. Choose a percentage and commit to it. Remember that everything is a gift from God. Let your giving be an act of faithfulness and give with joy.

Q: What if I want to give more, but now is not the time?

A: We know that the idea of increasing your giving can seem overwhelming. We encourage you to grow in your practice of giving. Figure out the percentage of your giving over the past year. Before giving, ask God to help you determine the percentage you will give this year. Taking a step forward in giving can have a tremendous impact on your relationship with God and the ways you use your personal resources.

Q: What's a pledge and why should I make one?

A: A pledge is a way for you to make a commitment to give a particular amount to Webster Hills UMC in 2023.

After you pray about your gift, writing it down is a step toward creating a plan to make your decision come to life.

Q: What methods can I use to make my offering?

A: You may make your offering during worship, online, text, or use your bank's bill payment service. Creating something automatic is an easy way to give regularly and makes the practice of giving meaningful and stress-free.

Q: What if my situation changes?

A: Life is unpredictable and your church wants you to give without worry. If your financial picture changes, let us know.

We want to pray for you as you face new challenges in life. You can also let us know the adjustments you need to make in your pledged giving. Of course, if life changes for the better, one way to celebrate can be with a special gift or an increased pledge!

Q: What else should I know?

A: Your gift is tax deductible. We will provide you with records of your giving to Webster Hills UMC. If you need help making arrangements for an online donation or making changes to your online giving, contact our office. You are welcome to talk with our pastor or any member of our leadership team to better understand the finances of our church. If you would like to donate stock or other resources, contact our office for guidance.

Q: Why Consider giving more?

A: Your church is growing and changing the lives of many people. We are dedicated to investing in staff, resources and our physical and online campus so that ministry can not only continue but grow.
